An Act of the County Assembly of Nyeri to provide for the administration of various taxes, fees and charges for services and other revenue raising measures by the County Government of Nyeri and for matters incidental thereto.

ENACTED by the County Assembly of Nyeri as follows—

| Purpose and Objective of this Act. | 3. The purpose and objective of this act is to provide for the administration of various taxes, fees and charges for services and other revenue raising measures by the County Government of Nyeri. |

| County Director of Revenue | 4. There is established an office of the County Director of Revenue |
| Functions of County Director of Revenue. | <p>5. The County Director of Revenue appointed under Section 4 above shall -</p> <p>(a) be responsible for the collection, receiving and accounting for all revenue payable to the County;</p> <p>(b) advise the county executive Secretary on all matters</p> |

relating to the administration and enforcement of collection of county revenue; and

(c) provide quarterly statements to the County Treasury with copies to the National Treasury and the Commission on revenue allocation;

(d) perform such other functions as the County Executive Secretary directs.

Delegation of functions and powers 6. (1) The Director may with the approval of the County Executive Secretary, in writing, delegate all or any of his or her functions or powers under this Act to a county public officer, except this power of delegation.

Appointment of revenue collectors and receivers 7. (1) The County Executive Secretary shall in writing designate persons to be responsible for collecting, receiving and accounting for revenue within the County Government of Nyeri.

(2) Any person appointed under sub section (1) shall not later than three days deliver the revenue collected to the County Revenue Collection account, present the deposit slips and revenue collection books to the director of revenue.

Agreement in relation to revenue collection 8. The County Executive Secretary may appoint a revenue agent to collect revenue on behalf of the County Government on such terms and conditions as shall be agreed upon in an agreement.

PART III - BOOKS AND RECORDS OF ACCOUNTS AND REPORTING

Books and Records of Accounts 9. (1) The Director shall keep proper books, information and accounts of all revenue collected, received and paid into the revenue collection account.

(2) The said books, information and records shall be subject to audit and reported upon by the Auditor General.

Annual reporting 10. (1) The Director shall at the end of every financial year prepare an account in respect of revenue collected, received and recovered during that financial year

(2) The account under subsection(1) (a) shall include-

- (a) a statement of receipts and disbursements in a form prescribed by the accounting standards board;
 - (b) a statement of arrears of revenue.
- (3) The Director shall not later than three months after the end of the financial year –
- (a) submit the accounts to the Auditor General
 - (b) deliver a copy to the National Treasury, the Controller of Budget, County Treasury and the commission on Revenue Collection.
- (4) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (1), The Director shall within 90 days after the end of every year give a report to the county Executive Secretary for the purposes of revenue administration within the County.
- (5) The County Executive Secretary shall upon receipt of the report under subsection (4) table the report in the county assembly.

PART IV – MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

Waiver and

11. (1) The County Executive Secretary may in accordance to section 159 of the Public Finance and Management Act waive or vary a county tax, fee or charge imposed by the County.

(2) The County Executive Secretary shall no later than two months after the end of each financial year submit to the County Assembly Committee a report in respect to all waivers and variation of taxes, fees or charges granted during that year in such manner as provided for under section 165(5) of the Public Finance and Management Act, 2012

Identification

12. (1) In performing any function or exercising any power under this Act, any county revenue receiver appointed under section 7 must produce written identification establishing his or her position if requested by a revenue payer.

General penalty
for offence

13. (1) Any person who fails to pay any of the fees, charge, taxes provided for under this act shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable to such fines as shall be provided for under this Act.

Rules

14. The County Executive Member responsible for Finance may make rules generally for the better carrying out of the provisions and purposes of this Act.
